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Description In 2021 this subject replaced by 401467 - Medical Research Project (PG). This subject is an essential part of the final year of the Masters of Advanced Imaging (MRI). It will consolidate and build on the students' knowledge and skills gained in prior subjects. Students will design and conduct a research project from an area of inquiry relevant to Advanced Imaging - MRI. Successful completion of the subject results in the composition of a report, and in an oral presentation which will include details of the aims, methods, results and conclusions of the project.
