Description This subject introduces specialist historical research on diverse genders and sexualities of the past in a variety of world cultures, including First Nations. It teaches the differing ways that forms of gender identity, and sexual desire have been articulated, construed and regulated across time and place. It fosters understanding of the value, gender biases and ethics of generative AI use for historical inquiry of gender and sexuality. It develops reading and writing skills needed for creating gender and sexuality history content for media. It provides training in writing a research project proposal in history of sexuality or gender.
