Description This subject is concerned with the design, development and maintenance of computer software systems. The subject focuses on current formal specification and system verification technologies and methodologies. Foundations of model checking such as Linear Temporal Logic and Computation Tree Logic, as well as a particular practical model checker SPIN will be thoroughly studied in this subject. The SPIN model checker with programming language PROMELA will be used for all software development and verification practices throughout this subject. The subject plays an important part in preparing students for career paths as software engineers and IT developers.

4. Formulate PROMELA programs and apply SPIN model checker to specify and verify the correctness of various software systems and programs.
5. Evaluate different formal methods in relation to the performance of formal specification and verification tasks for various practical software systems.
6. Develop a functional verification prototype system for an actual software project, using advanced SPIN model checker and PROMELA programming methodologies.
